

2006 T.C.C.R.A. ELECTION PROCEDURES

1. Candidates must be a club member in good standing at the time of nomination and must be 18 years of age; 21 years of age for Board of Directors. Board of Director nominees must also have served at least one (1) full term as an Officer Committee member. All nominees for the office of President must have served as a Committee Member for at least one year or have been a member in good standing for a minimum period of five (5) years. If needed, the Board of Directors will interview potential presidential candidates.

- If you are a promoter with TCCRA you may not serve on the Officer Committee or Board of Directors.
- No association member or immediate family member may serve on the Officer Committee and Board of Directors at the same time, beginning with the 2000 elections. To eliminate potential conflict of interest, 2 or 3 members of the same family may not serve on Board of Directors at the same time. Board of Directors may not hold any other elected office during the same season.

2. Anyone running for Track Supervisor must have served at least one (1) year as a track assistant.

3. Candidates must run for a specific office.

4. Elections will be held annually to replace outgoing Officers. Election shall be held at the year-end banquet.

5. Officers' terms will be for two (2) years. Exception: the offices of, E-Scoring Trailer Transporter and Web Master Officer, terms will be one (1) year. Notice, the E-Scoring Trailer Transporter and the Web Master Officer are appointments by the Board of Directors. Board of Directors' terms will be for three (3) years, one elected each year. Third year Director shall serve as Senior Board of Director in charge.

6. Nominations will be accepted up to and including November 30th. In the first week of December all nominees will be notified via telephone of their candidate status. The nominee will have 24 hours to decide to accept or reject the nomination. At that time, the nominee will be invited to submit via e-mail or regular mail, if he/she wishes a brief 100 word or less, statement demonstrating why he/she is seeking office. This statement will be posted on the web site as well as included on the official ballot. This statement is not mandatory and is not considered a requirement to hold office.

8. Votes will be tallied at the Year-end banquet by a minimum of two (2) Board of Directors. Other officers may be appointed by the President in a case of conflict of interest.

9. All votes shall be via secret ballot at the banquet or by mail-in vote on official ballot, provided duly notarized ballot is received by the club Secretary prior to the banquet date.

10. There shall be no flagrant campaigning done for any reason, i.e. no hanging of banners, soliciting of your positions and/or promises, passing out flyers, etc.

11. Voting results for each position will be announced at the year-end banquet by the President or person in charge in their absence.
